In case you're wondering what Katakana is and why you need it, well... here's a quick answer.

*Katakana is the equivalent of Hiragana. Same sounds. Same readings. Same number of characters. The only differences are that the Katakana characters look different and are used for **foreign words from other languages** like...*

- your name – for example, Mike – マイク
- coffee – コーヒー
- computer – コンピュータ
- **and it's scientific/medical terms.**

That's why Katakana exists and that's why it's used. Nothing else.

Below is the chart of all of the Katakana characters that you need to know. Look it over from right to left. As you can see, they mostly follow the a, i, u, e, o pattern. This will be your lover during your Katakana learning process and you will refer to it constantly.
